- New German law on wind energy to reduce reliance on Russian gas
- Rapid increase in windturbines
- Many near border areas, impacting neighbors
- Similar issues at the German-Czech border
- Ongoing talks with the national government
- Legal action against uncoordinated approvals



Succes stories from Gelderland: EU subsidies 2021-2027 Gelderland

- €470 million in EU subsidies to Gelderland
- 352 organizations participated
- Top 3 of 12 Dutch provinces secured most EU funding
- 6,581 FTE jobs created
- Strengthens argument for EU network participation
