

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1991 (REGIONAL ASSEMBLIES)
(ESTABLISHMENT) ORDER 2014


In the performance of its functions, a regional assembly shall have regard to the general welfare, strategic planning and sustainable development requirements of the region, including:

- a) The physical, economic, social, demographic, infrastructural, and environmental situation of the region, its economic and other development potential, and the protection or improvement of its environmental, heritage, amenity, and cultural resources.
- b) The programmes, plans, policies, proposals, and objectives of the Government and of any Minister of the Government and of local authorities and other public authorities, as appropriate, and the need to promote coordination of and/ or consistency with them.
- c) The resources that are available, or are likely to be available, for the performance of their functions.
- d) The specific need for coordinated action to promote effectiveness in local government and public services, to promote consistency with the programmes, plans, policies, proposals, and objectives of the Government or Minister of the Government, and to ensure coherent spatial planning and sustainable development within and between regions.





Public Sector Equality and Human Rights Duty

The Public Sector Equality and Human Rights Duty ('the Duty') is a statutory obligation for public bodies (IHREC Act 2014).

Requires public bodies, in the performance of their functions, to have regard to the need to eliminate discrimination, promote equality and protect human rights of staff and people availing of their services.

Members' Allowances & Expenses Information

Fixed Annual Allowance

Based on distance and attendance rate (min 80% for full allowance)
Paid Quarterly
Current Local Government Rates

Travel & Subsistence Claims

Submit to Finance as frequently as possible (for example monthly)

Conferences/Training

Must be pre-booked through the Assembly Use official claim forms

Use Aggregated travel form to keep track

Submit EFT & Distance Declarations as soon as possible!
