Objective: Develop or Enhance an Integrated Urban Strategies and fund Capital Projects for Designated Settlements for the adaptive reuse of Heritage Buildings

Who Can Apply: Local Authorities



Why: To Reduce Vacancy & Dereliction in line with Town Centre First Approach and values of the New European Bauhaus



When: Call Now Open – deadline for applications 5/4/24 Strand 1 and 3/5/24 Strand 2

Total Funding: €120 million

Strand 1 - Plans and project development measures: €40 -€200k Integrated urban strategies, feasibility studies, site investigations, planning, consents, environmental screening etc.



Strand 2 - 'Ready to go' capital works projects: €2m - €7m Design, consents and planning in place, conservation skills etc

Strand 1 – Integrated Urban Strategies and project Pipeline Development

- Development and enhancement of integrated urban strategies using a Town Centre First Framework.
- Identification of projects that promote the conservation and adaptive reuse of our built heritage stock while reducing vacancy and dereliction in town centres.
- Prioritisation, development and specification of project proposals to create a pipeline of investment-ready built heritage refurbishment, renovation and adaptive reuse projects.

Who Can Apply and For How Much?

- Local Authorities with a designated settlement.
- Restricted to 1 application for each designated settlement.
- This will be a competitive funding call.
- Funding will be for amounts between €40k and €200k for each designated settlement.
- 100% grant funding available to Local Authorities

Eligible Expenditure

- Direct staff costs
- Direct staff T&S
- Consultancy/ professional expertise
- Survey/site investigation
- Capacity building
- Room hire stakeholder or citizen
 engagement
- Communication/publicity
- Other Direct Costs
- Indirect Cost will be paid at 7% of eligible direct costs

Town Centre First Heritage Revival Scheme



An Integrated Urban Strategy will set the following:

- State the geographical area
- List the development needs and potential of the area
- Describe the integrated approach to addressed these needs and potential
- Outline the partners involved and the multi-level governance and bottom-up approach
- List the potential projects for redevelopment/regeneration or adaptive reuse



Strand 2 – Renovation and Adaptive Reuse of Vacant or Derelict Heritage Buildings

- Delivery of selected pilot and pathfinder projects that will have a positive and transformative impact on town centre vacancy and dereliction and that will inform the approach for other towns at earlier stages in the process.
- Projects will take a citizen and community led approach to planning and design for the adaptive reuse of vacant and derelict buildings, using the Town Centre First framework and embracing the New European Bauhaus values by ensuring projects are sustainable, beautiful, accessible and inclusive.
- Buildings must be in **local authority ownership** or with a property transfer/sharing agreement with a state body in place.

Who Can Apply and For How Much?

- Local Authorities with a designated settlement.
- Restricted to 1 application per Local ٠ Authority for a designated settlement
- This will be a competitive funding call.
- Funding will be for amounts ٠ between €2 million and €7 million for each project selected.
- 100% Grant Funding Available to Local Authorities

Heritage Buildings





- Heritage buildings under THRIVE are considered structures that form part of the architectural heritage and are of special architectural, historical, archaeological, artistic, cultural, scientific, social or technical interest.
- Heritage buildings will be a Protected Structure, a Proposed Protected Structure, or will contribute significantly to the character of an Architectural Conservation Area.
 - These buildings may include a mix of typologies ranging from large-scale institutional or industrial buildings, such as schools, barracks, courthouses, churches, convents, castles, etc. to other historic landmark buildings such as banks, post-offices and courthouses that have fallen into redundancy, and where their rehabilitation and reuse has potential to drive significant town centre regeneration.

THRIVE – New European Bauhaus (NEB)

- THRIVE places citizens and their communities at the heart of the development of integrated urban strategies, the reimagination of town centres and the creative and sustainable reuse of vacant or derelict heritage buildings in public control or ownership.
- The promotion of the values and working principles of the NEB under THRIVE will ensure that the selected projects are conceived and developed with a reinforced citizen and stakeholder involvement.

Core Values & Principles of the NEB

- <u>Sustainability Value</u> from climate goals to circularity and biodiversity.
- <u>Aesthetics (Beauty) Value</u> quality of experience and style, beyond functionality.
- <u>Inclusion Value</u> including accessibility and affordability.
- <u>NEB Principles</u> require a multi-level, participatory and transdisciplinary approach.
