1. Adoption of Minutes of Meeting held on 9th April

2. Matters Arising

3. Blue Green Infrastructure (BGI) & Nature Based Solutions (NbS) Framework - Emma Oldroyd, ARUP

Bryan Riney gave an update on the Blue Green Infrastructure (BGI) and Nature Based Solutions (NBS) and its implementation through the Blue Green City project which is co-finance by INTERREG Europe. Emma Oldroyd, ARUP gave a presentation (copy available) on the Blue Green Infrastructure and Nature-based Solutions Framework for the Southern Region.

A discussion followed with contributions from the Cathaoirleach, Cllr. O'Callaghan, Cllr. Kelly; Cllr. Boyle, Cllr. Kelleher, Cllr. Murnane and Cllr. McCarthy. Key issues discussed included:

A need for a more ecosystem approach in local authorities;

- A need for circular economy in sustainability for resource management;
- A need to emphasise the importance of environmental indicators;
- A need to simplify the terminology when dealing with the general public;
- A need to target primary schools;
- How the framework can assist local authorises in defining and implementing "Blue Green" or nature-based solutions.

4. Presentation by Teresa Lennon of the Irish Regions European Office (IREO)

Teresa Lennon presented an update of the work of the Committee of the Regions (CoR), including the involvement of the CoR Members that sit on the Assembly.

Cllr. Michael Murphy, Head of the Irish Delegation acknowledged the hard work that Teresa Lennon and IREO do for Ireland in the EU.

The Cathaoirleach and the Members thanked Teresa for her presentation and asked Members to subscribe to the IREO newsletter. Points arising included:

- Members to support their local authorities to engage with the IREO regarding EU Policy and funding opportunities;
- The benefits of having European Policy/Project officers in all local authorities.

5. Any Other Business

- Regarding a query raised by Cllr. Kelly concerning ongoing online/hybrid meetings David Kelly advised that DHLGH have confirmed the intention retain the option for Councils' and Regional Assemblies to meet using an online/hybrid format to promote family friendly and flexible practices.

- Cllr. Dan Boyle asked for the All Island Strategic Rail Review to be discussed at a future Regional Assembly meeting.
