Monitoring committee >

Is the programme's central decision-making body.



Audit authority/ group of auditors >

Is responsible for system audits and sample audits of projects.



Accounting Body >

Makes payment to projects and submits claims for funding to the European Commission.



Managing authority >

Manages the programme on behalf of participating partner countries. Signs subsidy contracts with the selected projects.



Joint secretariat >

Carries out the operational administration of the programme. It also assists all the other programme bodies with their tasks.



National points of contact >

Operate in each partner state as a national or regional representative and can provide programme information in local languages.
